

# Melon

## Boeing F1

- Ananas type with a very good plant cover and a good heat setting.
- Average fruit weight of 3 Kg.
- Fruits are sweet (brix 12°) with a golden skin, an orange flesh and a strong aroma.
- Firm oval fruits with good shape and size uniformity.
- PM, F 0,1,2

The word RESISTANCE is used to define the ability of a plant variety to restrict the activity of a plant pathogen or insect and restrict the symptoms of a disease compared to a susceptible plant variety.  
The word TOLERANCE is used to define the ability of a plant to endure or recover from the damage caused by such pests and pathogen caused symptoms.

GUIDE TO DISEASES: BSK - Bacterial Speck (*Pseudomonas syringae* pv. *tomato*); ASC - Alternaria Stem Canker (*Alternaria alternata* f.sp. *lycopersici*, races 1, 2, &3); F - Fusarium wilt (*Fusarium oxysporum* f.sp. *lycopersici*, races 1, 2 & 3); St - Grey leaf spot (*Stemphylium solani*); V - Verticillium wilt (*Verticillium dahliae*, race 1); ToMV – Tomato Mosaic Virus (Strains: 0,1 & 2); TYLCV - Tomato Yellow Leaf Curl Virus; TSWV – Tomato Spotted Wilt Virus; N – Southern root-knot Nematode (*Meloidogyne incognita*, *M. arenaria*, *M. javanica*, race 1).
